- Application Fees are non-refundable.

- You will receive a 10X10 area for the duration of the festival (11am 10pm on Saturday September 9th & 11am - 7pm Sunday, September 10th, 2017). Set up times will be communicated closer to the festival date. All vendors must supply their own tents and any fixtures. Tents must be weighted to withstand wind.
- It is not mandatory to keep your vendor booth active beyond 7pm on Saturday. If you choose to operate your booth past 7pm and require lighting you must provide your own self powered lighting.
- All drugs and drug paraphernalia are strictly prohibited from being sold and/or displayed.
- The Cabbagetown Festival is not responsible for your any loss or damage over the
